

Behaviour Management Policy

Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to help maintain a safe, supportive and protective learning community that promotes student safety and wellbeing, whereby students and teachers are able to work in the school environment free from disruption, abuse or threats and within which they can reach their potential as teachers and learners.

Scope

This policy applies to every student from Prep to Year 12 and is strictly non-discriminatory, as it applies to all students equally. This policy applies to behaviour within the school grounds, the classroom, when representing the school in public, on camps, school excursions and activities in an online environment.

Policy

The Behaviour Management policy aims to set in place the procedure and guidelines whereby students and teachers are able to work in an environment free from disruption, fear, abuse or threat and within which they can reach their potential as teachers and learners.

At Freshwater Christian College we believe that for effective learning to take place we need to create a safe, supportive and disciplined environment that respects the following rights:

- *Students have the right to learn*
- *Teachers have the right to teach*
- *Everyone has the right to be safe*

There is an expectation that every student obeys all of the rules of the College and is aware that there are consequences should they choose to disregard them. The College may suspend or terminate enrolment at its discretion for failure to comply with these conditions or other breaches of the school's rules and regulations. **Such termination may be for a singular serious incident or for failure over a period of time to correct repetitive less serious breaches.**
