

# FEE SCHEDULE (LOCAL) 2020 v1

The following fees apply to students who are Australian Residents/Citizens.  
All fees are reviewed annually in October and may be subject to yearly increase.



## TUITION FEES PER YEAR

As always, we endeavour to keep our fees as low as possible. This year there are some increases to fees due to the implementation of new technology including the Secondary managed device program (all students in Years 7 - 10 will be issued with a leased Chromebook laptop) as detailed in the letter sent to parents on 20 November 2019.

The annual tuition fee covers all compulsory curriculum activities including excursions and camps. This ensures there are no surprise costs during the year so that families can budget effectively. Sibling discounts apply when a family has two or more children attending the College at the same time. The 1<sup>st</sup> child rate applies to the child in the highest year level.

## PAYMENT OPTIONS

Tuition fees are billed annually and are payable at the beginning of the year by the **due date**. Families have the option of paying annual fees **up-front** or on a **payment plan** spread over a number of instalments throughout the year.

### OPTION 1: Up-front payment

A **5% Discount** applies when Annual Tuition Fees are fully paid by due date stated on the annual invoice. This does not apply to students starting part way through the year. Annual Payments can be paid by one of the following methods:

- In Person Cash, Cheque, EFTPOS or Credit Card (VISA or MasterCard only)
- By Mail Personal Cheque or Money Order
- By Internet\* Direct credit transfers for fees can be made directly to the College bank account for **Annual Fee Payments only**. College Bank Account Details:

\* If using internet banking, **please ensure that you use your numerical account code shown on your invoice as the payment reference** to ensure payment allocation is to the correct account.

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## OPTION 2: Payment plan

**Direct Debit\*\***      Weekly, fortnightly or monthly direct debit from your nominated bank account or credit card (VISA or MasterCard only). On receipt of the signed Direct Debit Payment Plan form D1, the College will automatically debit your nominated account or credit card when your payment is due.

\*\* The maximum length of a payment plan is 10 months, i.e. from February to November, with the final payment on any plan due by the end of November each year.

## OTHER FEES & CHARGES

**Application Fee** (non-refundable)      \$110 per application/student (includes GST)  
**Enrolment Deposit\*** (Non-refundable)      \$400 per family

\* This applies to new families only and applied against the Parents account once the child/ren start attending school. This is non-refundable unless 60 days notice is given prior to child/ren attending school.

### BUS SERVICE FEES

Bus Fees are payable at the beginning of each term unless they are included in the Direct Debit Payment Plan. If fee payments fall behind, we reserve the right to suspend the bus service until the fee payments have been brought up to date. Only students who have paid their Bus Fees in full or payment plans are up to date will be allowed on the Bus.

Casual Bus fees are payable in advance of travel at Finance Reception. Please contact the College Bus Administrator for all enquiries and bookings for the bus service.

### INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC PROGRAM

For students receiving private instrumental music tuition, costs will be charged directly to families by the individual music tutors involved.

### LIBRARY RE-STOCKING FEES

Students are required to return all borrowed items to the library by the due dates advertised in Term 4 each year. A re-stocking fee will be charged for any items not returned by the due date.

### STATIONERY

Stationery for Primary students (P-6) is included in the Tuition Fees and is provided by the College. Stationery for Secondary Students (7-12) is not included in the Tuition Fees and students are to purchase the requirements externally as per the list issued by the College.

### STUDENT DIARIES

Each student will be provided with a diary on their first day of school, the cost of which is covered in the annual tuition fee. Replacements (for lost/damaged diaries) are available from Finance Reception for \$20.

### UNIFORMS

Uniform costs are not included in the tuition fees and are payable separately to the Uniform Shop run on the College campus by Weareco Pty Ltd.

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
